We want to thank everyone for attending our last spaghetti dinner and invite you to the next dinner on August 1st at the Temple dining room.

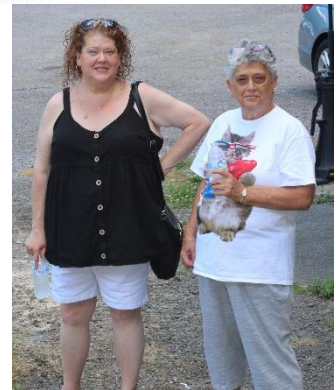
