



Over 40 items were donated from community businesses and our participating vendors along with the Picnic Gazebo donated from Noble Jake Miller and Summer Basket by Tawni. Four (4) bikes were raffled off and were purchased with the help of a few Ali Ghan Units and personal checks from Robin Summerfield, Jim Cunningham and Mark Lathrop.
